Expomed Eurasia 2025 Opened Its Doors to the World of Healthcare!

Türkiye's largest trade event in the healthcare sector, Expomed Eurasia, has opened its doors for the 32nd time at the Tüyap Fair and Congress Center in Istanbul. Taking place from April 24–26, 2025, the exhibition stands out as a major meeting point where innovative products and future-shaping technologies in healthcare are showcased.

Bringing together representatives of the global medical industry in Istanbul, Expomed Eurasia 2025 is drawing significant international attention. This year, the event is expected to welcome over 25,000 visitors, including 5,000 international attendees from more than 120 countries. Over 650 domestic and international companies and representatives are exhibiting the latest solutions of the medical sector across six halls.

As a strategic meeting point for international collaborations and new investment opportunities, Expomed Eurasia 2025 significantly contributes to Türkiye's goal of regional leadership in healthcare technologies. The event allows local manufacturers to promote their products and brands on the global stage, while new business connections formed with international visitors enhance the sector's investment potential.
